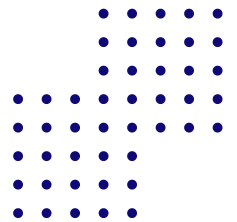




GRACE BUS COME AND HEAL





A BRIEF WORD

If you're wondering how a single mobile medical bus could transform villages across Africa, you don't have to look far for the answer.

It stands on two mountains: provision and prayer.
And prayer carries both.

Grace Bus was not born from ambition. It was born from compassion – and obedience.

In 2025, before there was a formal launch plan, before there was a structured pilot model, there was Zoggu. A team went to listen before acting. They met with leaders. They spoke with health workers. They prayed with families. What followed was not spectacle, but service – medical care delivered with dignity, partnership built on trust, and a community strengthened rather than replaced.

From that moment, something became clear:

Healthcare is compassion in motion.

But what begins in one village does not end there.

What is strengthened in one cluster does not remain contained.

and the fear no one names.

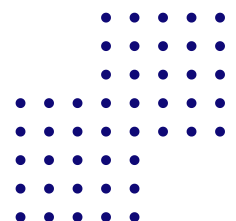
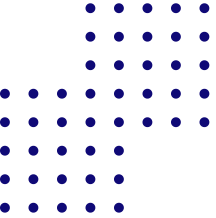
We stand before You as servants,

to the mercy that comes from You alone.

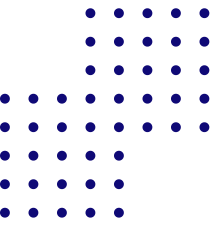
Consecrate this mission.

Where there is neglect, bring dignity.





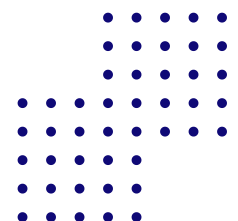
Where there is disease, bring treatment.
